- b. List each child in your household and their age.

**4. FINANCIAL INFORMATION:**

Describe any financial need you may have.  
How do you plan to pay for your college education? (Parent Contribution, Working, Savings)  
List other scholarships or grants you have applied for and any response (pending or awarded)

**5. ACADEMIC INFORMATION:**

Send transcript with present and cumulative GPA and rank in class or ask a counselor to send an email with that information. If possible, include SAT scores.

**6. OTHER INFORMATION:** Attach any other pertinent information you wish to include such as a letter of recommendation.
